ACTS CLUBHOUSE MEMBERSHIP FAQs

Who can become a Clubhouse member?

Any adult (age 18 or older) living with a mental illness may become a member of ACTS Clubhouse, regardless of diagnosis. Membership is voluntary, inclusive, and has no time limits.

How often can I come to the Clubhouse?

You decide how often you attend. Some members come every day, while others visit based on their personal schedules. ACTS Clubhouse is a lifelong opportunity—membership is what you make it. As we say, “Once a member, always a member.” Even after a long absence, members are always welcome to return and participate.

How do I become a member of ACTS Clubhouse?

ACTS Clubhouse opened in Fall 2023 serving Hillsborough County residents. The first step to becoming a member is scheduling a tour. To arrange a visit, email clubhouse@actsfl.org or call 813.771.0958. You will then complete an application.

What opportunities are available at the Clubhouse?

Members have access to a wide range of meaningful opportunities, including:

- Vocational training
- Supported education
- Employment opportunities
- Wellness activities
- Social and recreational opportunities
- Evening, weekend, and holiday events
- Connections to community-based supports

ACTS Clubhouse does not provide clinical or treatment services. Members are encouraged to continue participating in clinical care and other community-based services as part of their individual recovery journey.

A TYPICAL DAY AT ACTS CLUBHOUSE

What members enjoy most about ACTS Clubhouse is that each day offers meaningful opportunities to learn, connect, use personal strengths, and build lasting relationships. Members and staff work side by side to keep the Clubhouse running, and every member’s talents are valued. Taking part in the daily life of the Clubhouse helps build confidence and supports members as they work toward their personal goals.

THE WORK-ORDERED DAY

The heart of ACTS Clubhouse is the work-ordered day. During this time, members and staff work together as colleagues to carry out the activities that keep the Clubhouse operating. Members choose how they participate based on their interests, skills, and goals, creating a sense of purpose and belonging.

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

As part of membership, ACTS Clubhouse offers opportunities to return to paid employment through Transitional and Supported Employment in community-based work settings. Members receive on-the-job and offsite support from Clubhouse staff and fellow members every step of the way.

SOCIAL AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES

ACTS Clubhouse also offers social and recreational activities during evenings and weekends. These gatherings provide relaxed opportunities for members and staff to connect, have fun, and build friendships outside of the workday.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT

Members receive support connecting to community resources such as affordable housing, mental health and medical services, government benefits, and other supports they may need to live well in the community.
